

So, the good news is ...

While we are operating quite differently, we are definitely still actively fulfilling our rescue and rehoming mission! Since January, we've re-homed 114 cats and are pleased to be able to report that 24% of the adoptions were adult cats between the ages of 2 to 12. It is so good to see individuals recognize the great need these adults have to be re-established in forever homes after being displaced. We are glad, too, that we have a place like the Adoption Center that some call "home" for now, but we know without a doubt foster homes are always their best option for young and old alike. Please keep your hearts and minds open to the possibility of fostering a kindred kitty. Our current fosters can attest to how rewarding the experience can be! Despite the challenges of COVID-19, we made strides with spay/neuter. We've been able to "fix" 126 cats -68 kindred kitties, 47 owned cats and 11 neighborhood strays (TNR). 
